

HOW TO INFLATE THE BOARD

1



Unfold the board.



Insert pump hose into the valve and inflate to pressure written on the valve ring. Take extra care when using a compressor for inflation. We assume no liability for the use of a compressor.

2



Open the valve cap and make sure that the yellow pin is in the **UP position** (push and turn).



Detach the hose and close the valve cap.

INSTALLING FINS

Single fin

1



Put the square nut into the fin box and slide it to the front part of the box.

2



Put the single fin into the finbox. To do so, insert the pin of the fin into the fin box and push the fin backwards.

3



Position the square nut underneath the hole in the fin base and tighten the screw.

Thruster

1



Put the fins into the finboxes. The fins must point backwards and the TRIPSTIX-Logo must face to the outside. The centerfin does not have a logo.

2



Use the fin key, to tighten the screws. Do not tighten too strongly, as this may cause a damage to the finbox.

HOW TO DEFLATE THE BOARD

- 1 Clean and dry the board. Especially take care that no sand or dust remains at the valve.
- 2 Remove the fins. Release the screws and pull the fins to do so.



Open the valve cap. Push and turn the yellow pin so that it remains in the DOWN position. (push and turn)



Continue with folding from the nose.



Start folding from the tail, until you reach the valve.



Take care not to brake the valve cap when doing the last fold.



Close the strap to fix the package.

MAINTENANCE

- Do not expose to direct sunlight for an extended period of time.
- Prevent overheating!
- Do not use a compressor for inflation.
- Avoid contact with sharp obstacles.
- store at a dry place with room temperatur
- if possible, store the board inflated at low pressures (3-5PSI)
- clean and dry before packing
- Do not use aggressive chemicals for cleaning. (Soap-)water can be used for cleaning.
- tighten the valves from time to time

SAFETY

- Always wear an approved PFD (personal flotation device).
- Do not paddle under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Wear a helmet when appropriate.
- Do not paddle alone. Always inform someone of your paddling expedition.
- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Check weather conditions and dress accordingly.
- Beware of winds and currents.
- Do not exceed your paddling ability; be aware of your limitations.
- Be aware of safe river water levels, tidal changes, currents, and obstacles in and above the water.
- Check your equipment for damages prior to each use.
- Always wear a leash. Use a safety leash when paddling on rivers.
- Do not paddle in flood conditions.
- Do not paddle into protected areas (bird or fish protection etc.).
- This products contains synthetic materials like PVC, PES and EVA. Please dispose the product in an environmental friendly manner at a designated institution.
